# **Hazards and Pollution:**

# **Definition:**

A Pollution Incident is an incident or set of circumstances during or as a consequence of which, there is likely to be a leak, spill or other escape or deposit of a substance that causes pollution" (EPA Act S 153 and EPA guidelines 2012)

Potential hazards and pollution incidents include fuel spills, waste water flood, chemical leaks or spills, smoke, gas leakage, waste, chemical/hazardous substances leaks or spills.

# **Obligations:**

We all have obligations under the EPA Act to report, manage and clean up all pollution incidents. (29 February 2012).

# Actions to take during or immediately after a Pollution Incident:

Assess incident, risk, hazard/s and consequences

Danger to life or property

# **Inventory of Possible Pollution**

- See Irrigation Management Plan Stafford Everson is in charge of all Irrigation and will delegate IM to appropriately trained staff
- Waste water flood from treatment ponds low risk
- Equipment malfunction pumps, pipes irrigation water overflow from designated Irrigation Areas – medium - low risk
- Diesel spill low risk
- Chemical/substance spill low risk
- Salt low risk

# Safety Equipment

- PPE
- Diesel Tanks surrounded by concrete bund (see map). Kempsey Shire Council approved and low risk.
- All chemicals have MSDS stored in 25 kg plastic containers – in chemical storage sheds (see map).
   All relevant staff are trained in chemical storage and use
- Tallow stored in solid form in 30 tonne tank, low risk.
